

Objectives of the project

To fully restore the external fabric of this class A listed Georgian building. It was important to carry out the full restoration process, within budget and time constraints, whilst recognising the need for minimal disruption to the resident tenants and close neighbouring business.

Description of Works

- ♦ The designing, erecting and dismantling of scaffolding, allowing access to carry out the following works..
- Renewal of architectural leadwork.
- Repair and refurbishment of metal balconies.
