Introduction

After Submitting a competitive tender, Restrorex were appointed as principal contractors to carry out the billed works package.

Objectives of the project

To fully restore the external fabric of this large class c listed building. It was important to carry out the full restoration process, within budget and time constraints, whilst recognising the need for minimal disruption to the sitting tenants & close neighbouring business .

Description of Works

- ♦ The designing, erecting and dismantling of significant areas of scaffolding, allowing access to carry out the following works
- ♦ Retention and repair of existing windows
- Joinery repair and renewal to roofs
